<p>Text types: Explanations, Poetry, Traditional tales and play scripts.</p> <p>Sentences: Children will continue to develop the use of a range of punctuation within their writing such as full stops, commas, question marks, exclamation marks and speech marks. Children will also continue to develop the structure of their sentences through the use on simple, compound and complex sentences in their writing.</p> <p>Word: Children will continue to use adjectives, time connectives, nouns and verbs in the correct context. They will also develop and enhance their vocabulary through their topic.</p>	<p>Area of the maths curriculum will include:</p> <p>During this half term the children will continue to learn about multiplication and division. We will be reciting times tables regularly to ensure the children know the remaining times tables.</p> <p>Other areas of Maths we will cover this term include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Fractions ➤ Time- recapping time telling and looking at time in Roman Numerals ➤ Measurements- Length, Capacity and weight 	<p>This term our theme in class is: The Romans. Within this theme we will be covering the following subjects:</p> <p>History - As the topic is History based the children have identified lots of areas they would like to find out about The Romans. We will be looking at Roman Empire, Roman Britain, Rulers and Emperors and life within the Roman times such as Gladiators and housing.</p> <p>Geography- This term the children will be learning how to use maps and grid references to help locate a destination. The children will also learn about the Equator, Tropics of Cancer and Capricorn and about Greenwich Mean Time.</p> <p>Art- This term we will be focusing a lot of our art around The Romans. The children will be exploring Art during the Roman times such as pottery, mosaics, printing and paintings.</p> <p>DT- This term the children will be doing a lot of work on designing and testing prototypes for structures linked to our topic. The children will be creating model chariots, aqueducts and catapults and testing the materials used to make them.</p> <p>Music- This term we will be looking at learning about the history of music and how it developed and changed throughout time.</p> <p>Science Core - This term the children will be learning about forces and magnets. The children will also be using their investigative skills linked to their topic and DT work.</p>	<p>ICT Skills - This term the children will be learning all about networking and the internet. The children will be using the internet to compose and write emails to each other as well as learning about being safe on the internet.</p> <p>PE- This term the children will be composing their own gladiator dance routine. The children will be creating a dance around the movements and travelling during a gladiator fight. The children will compose this routine in groups and then show them to their peers.</p> <p>RE - Children will be learning all about Moses, Exodus and the festival of Pesach.</p> <p>MFL - This term the children will continue to learn develop their learning and understanding of French. Children will learn about gender of such as un and une and continue to expand their language skills.</p> <p>SMSC- We will be discussing with the children safety on the internet in school and at home. The children will also be learning about the festival of Pesach and will also discuss the story of Easter and Lent before Easter half term.</p>	<p>Please continue to learn all times tables with your child. We will be testing the children every Friday and they can only move onto the next table once they have achieved 12 out of 12.</p> <p>Please continue to read with your child every night and remember to sign their reading record book, as we love to know how the children are getting on at home.</p>
